Uniform Guidelines P – 12



1.0 Rationale

- 1.1 The students of Santa Sabina College (the College) identify themselves in the larger community by willingly wearing the College uniform with pride and respect. Students are required at all times to wear the correct College uniform and to ensure that all articles of clothing are clean, presentable and clearly labelled with the student's name.
- 1.2 If for religious, cultural or medical reasons a student is unable to comply with the requirements that follow, a formal written request from parents/carers is to be submitted to the College Principal.
- 1.3 Students are to wear the College uniform (SSC), purchased from the Uniform Shop.

2.0 College Uniform

2.1 All students must possess:

- SSC blazer with crest (compulsory when wearing winter uniform)
- SSC hat (which must be worn when outside on the College grounds at any time; can also be worn to and from school at the student's discretion)
- SSC jumper (to be worn under the blazer outside the College premises; can be worn without the blazer on site)
- SSC socks
- Black school shoes
- SSC black backpack
- SSC black sports bag

Summer Uniform

Years K - 9 (Girls)

- SSC summer dress or SSC long pants or SSC shorts – all worn with SSC socks
- Short sleeve white shirt
- SSC socks
- SSC hat

Years K - 4 (Boys)

- SSC short sleeved striped shirt
- SSC short pants
- SSC socks
- SSC bucket hat or legionnaires cap

Years 10 - 12

- SSC senior striped skirt or SSC long pants or SSC shorts – all worn with SSC socks
- SSC short sleeved white shirt
- SSC socks
- SSC hat

Prep

- SSC PE polo shirt
- SSC PE shorts
- SSC tracksuit pants
- SSC fleece jumper
- SSC bucket hat
- white socks

Winter Uniform

Blazer

The blazer is a compulsory part of the winter uniform. It is to be worn on all occasions outside the College grounds and all formal occasions on the Campus.

Winter Uniform

Years K – 9 (Girls)

- SSC black blazer
- (Year 5 9) SSC striped skirt worn with plain black tights or SSC long socks or SSC long pants worn with SSC socks
- (Year K 4) SSC striped tunic worn with SSC long socks
- SSC red jumper
- SSC long or short sleeved white shirt
- Plain black tights and/or SSC socks
- SSC scarf
- SSC hat

Years K - 4 (Boys)

- SSC black blazer
- SSC long sleeved striped shirt
- SSC long or short pants
- SSC red jumper
- SSC socks
- SSC tie
- SSC bucket hat or legionnaires cap

Years 10 - 12

- SSC black blazer
- SSC senior striped skirt worn with plain black tights or SSC long pants with SSC socks
- SSC long or short sleeved white shirt
- SSC black jumper
- Plain black tights or SSC socks
- SSC scarf
- SSC hat

Prep

- SSC PE polo shirt
- SSC PE shorts
- SSC tracksuit pants
- SSC fleece jumper
- SSC bucket hat
- white socks

PDHPE Uniform K - 12

- SSC sports shorts
- SSC polo shirt
- SSC sports socks
- SSC tracksuit
- SSC sports cap/visor for sun protection Compulsory Terms 1 and 4; encouraged Terms 2 and 3
- SSC sports bag

- SSC swimming costume
- SSC rash shirt
- House colour swimming cap
- House colour shirt (K-5)
- Appropriate sports shoes lace-up with adequate support and grip (Dunlop Volleys, Vans and Converse are not appropriate)
- SSC boardshorts to be worn during aquatics only (optional)

2.2 Hair

All students are required to maintain tidy hair of a single natural colour. When the hair reaches the collar, all of it must be tied back neatly, with a plain elastic natural coloured hair tie or black scrunchie.

Students may wear hair accessories available from the Uniform Shop including:

- SSC ribbon
- SSC headband
- SSC hair clip

Uniform Guidelines P-12 Efficacy: October 2023 At House events, students may wear their House coloured ribbons. House ribbons are available from the Uniform Shop.

2.3 Skirt and dress length

Students wearing the College dress or skirt are not permitted to shorten the length. Dresses and skirts are to reach the middle of the knee.

2.4 **Jewellery**

The only jewellery permitted to be worn is a watch, the College lapel cross, one pair of plain sleepers or studs (silver, gold, clear stone or small pearl) for pierced ears which need to be placed in each lower earlobe in matching positions. Other studs or sleepers are inappropriate for school and are not to be worn.

2.5 Makeup and nails

Makeup, false eyelashes, false nails including acrylics, any nail polish including shellac or SNS and ink markings are not to be worn.

3.0 PDHPE Uniform: (Years 5 – 12)

The full PDHPE uniform is compulsory for practical PE lessons.

4.0 Co-curricular and representative sport

Competitive sports may require specific attire. Requirements will appear on individual sports contracts and permission notes. For all other sporting commitments the purchase of the sports uniform would be required and this can be discussed with the Uniform Shop. Whilst travelling to and from sports, enclosed shoes and sports tracksuit need to be worn.

5.0 Out of hours: (Years 5 – 12)

Students who have sport training after school may travel in their sports uniform if they leave the College premises after 4:00pm. In such cases, only full sports uniform or full College uniform may be worn, not a combination of these. If training occurs before 7:30am students may wear full sports uniform or full College uniform to school. The expectation is that students are to change into College uniform before Homeroom time.

6.0 Casual dress

Casual dress days occur in the College calendar for a number of reasons and when they do, students need to adhere to the following guidelines.

6.1 Casual dress guidelines:

- Clothing must be deemed appropriate for a College event, further specifications may be communicated.
- No pyjamas or 'onesies' are to be worn.
- No midriff or shoestring strap tops are to be worn.
- Shoes should be closed for practicality, warmth and WHS regulations (no thongs or ugg boots).
- Hats and sunscreen are required for outdoor activities.

- Sunglasses (approved by Cancer Council) are recommended for outdoor activities.
- Hair must be neat and tidy and tied up for practical lessons.

7.0 Excursions

Dress code for excursions will be outlined in advance of an excursion. In most circumstances, full College uniform is to be worn, unless students are advised that the College sports uniform would be more appropriate for practical reasons.
